Dr. ChinRee Sun Memorial Scholarship

Purpose:

The scholarship is provided in memory of Dr. ChihRee Sun who was a long time member of CSCCA and passed away in 2005. Dr. Sun was born and grew up in China. He later pursued high education in U.S. and earned a PhD degree in physics. Dr. Sun dedicated himself to education in most of his life. Even after he retired from State University of New York at Albany, he moved to South Florida and immersed himself in Chinese culture education.

He published more than 200 Chinese poems on newspapers in the past years; Dr. Sun was activity involved activities as CSCCA. He was enthusiastic in passing Chinese Heritage to the new generations. In his wish, his family donated and formed this scholarship in hope of encouraging new generations to learn and appreciate Chinese culture.

Eligibility:

1. Currently enrolled students of Coral Springs Chinese School with minimum of 2 years enrollment at the school are eligible.
2. Applicants must be active students who can listen, speak, read and write Chinese fluently.

Process:

1. Applications should be submitted by students **before the 28th of February** each year. (Please download application and essay form <http://coralspringschinese.org>)
2. Qualified Candidates will be notified by **the end of March**, They will be required to submit a copy of ***Hand-written*** essay in Chinese with Traditional Chinese essay format.
Intermediate - 300 words.
Advanced - 400 words.
3. After collected, applications should be reviewed and applicants may be interviewed by the scholarship committee.
4. Winners will be decided by the scholarship committee **before the 30th of April**.
5. Scholarship will be awarded by the end of year ceremony at the Coral Springs Chinese School.
